- Shoeboxes This year we are going to be preparing shoeboxes for a charity called Link To Hope which is a Christian charity that takes shoe boxes to the most poor and marginalised children and families in Eastern Europe. We are going to pack the boxes at our packing morning on Saturday 8th November. However, we really need shoeboxes this year so if anyone has any spare boxes lying around at home please could they be bought to the church or let me know so I can collect them.

The charity recommends adult shoe boxes. We are also asking for collections and donations to be left in the red boxes which will be at both centres.

Here is a list of things that can be put inside the boxes (it is a bit different from normal!): Gloves, scarf, hats, tea lights, toothbrush and toothpaste, soap, flannel, sweets and chocolate, games, pencils and notebooks, teddies, toys, tape measure, sewing kit, solar powered calculator, hairbrush, hot water bottle, work gloves, mug, wooden spoon, cutlery, reading glasses, sensory items e.g. lavender bags, socks/tights, wind up radio or torch.

This year we have the opportunity to pack a box for a family or for an elderly person which is why the list is so diverse and a bit different from last year.
